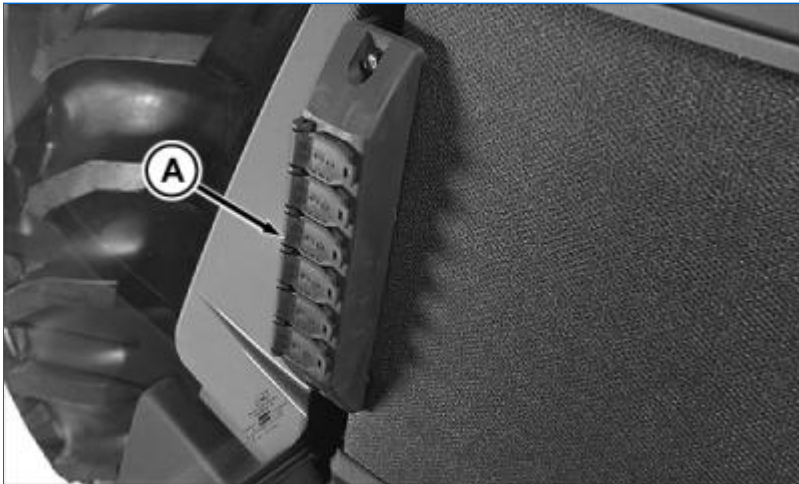

#### LEGEND:

A - Auxiliary Power Strip

#### **IMPORTANT:**

**Power strip is not a surge suppressor. Electrical equipment with program memory requires protection from damage of electrical surges and spikes.**

The power strip (A) provides six outlets, of 12-volt power with grounds. This power is 30 amp switched and 30 amp unswitched. The connectors can be used when connecting auxiliary equipment.

Adapters plug directly into power strip as unswitched power. To change to switched power on cigarette lighter adapter or standard adapter (with three wires), remove small tab at end of slot on plug and rotate plug 180°.

#### *NOTE:*

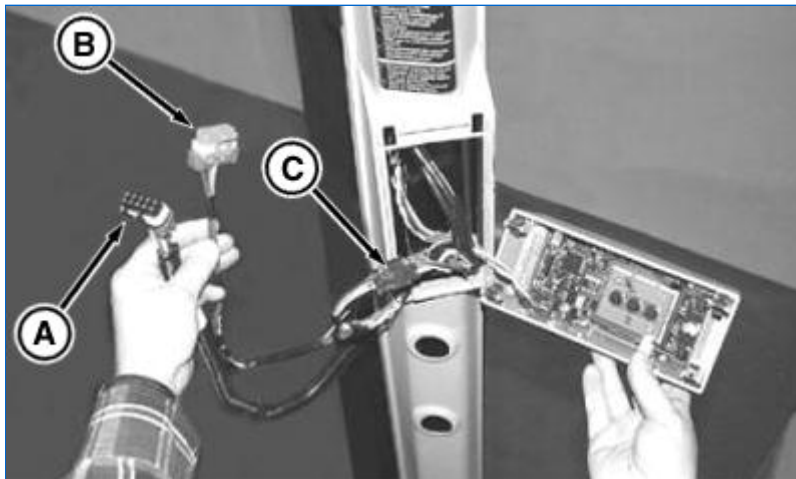
*The small white dot on adapter plug face next to the cap hinge indicates circuit is **unswitched** . If dot is opposite cap hinge, circuit is **switched** .*

Nine-Pin connector (A) located at rear of tractor.

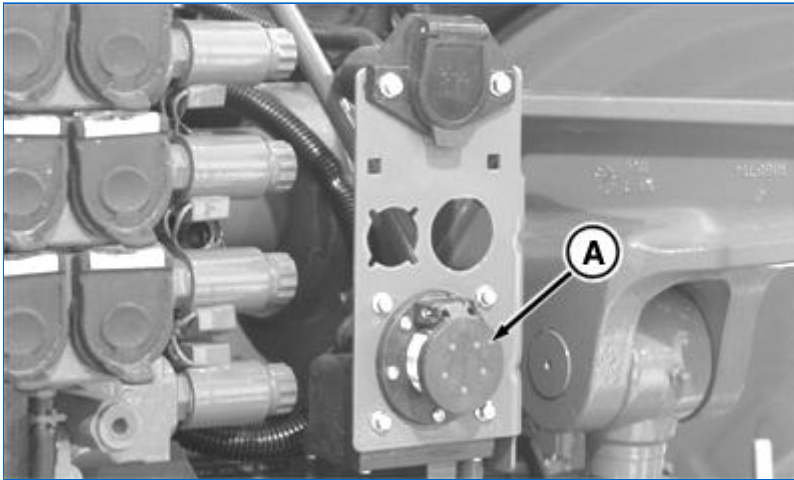

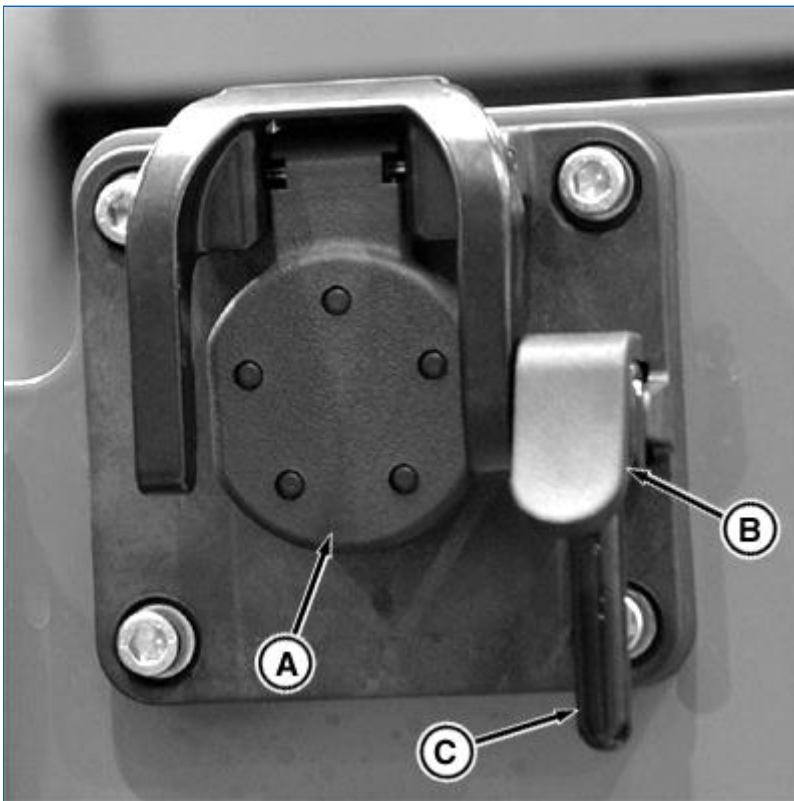

For later version tractors, push release (B) and pull handle (C) to open implement connector.

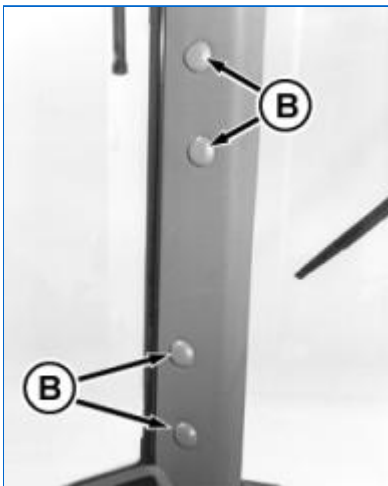

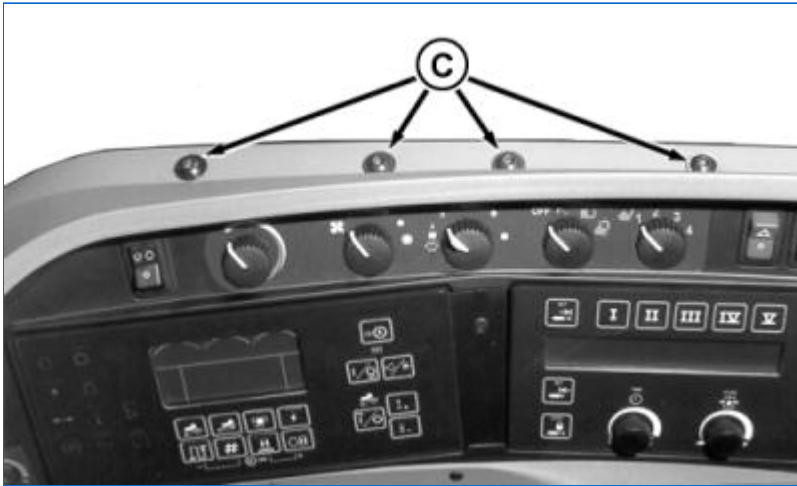
## Using Monitor Mounts

**A-Corner Post Display**

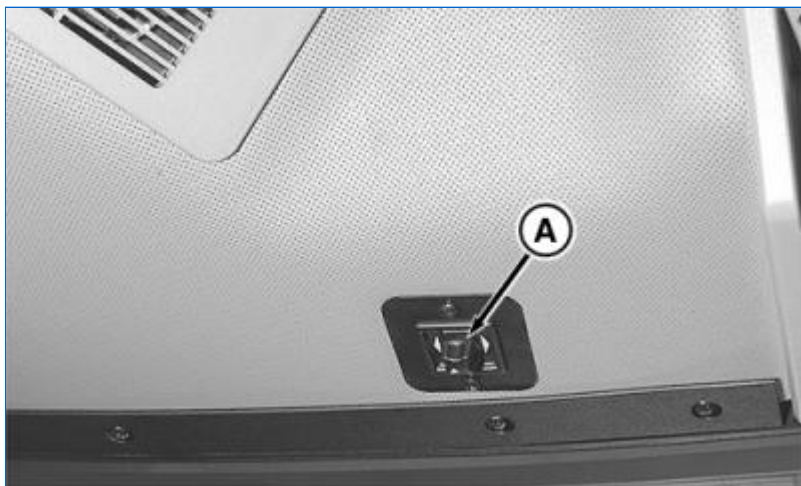
**B-Rear Cab Post**

Loosen knob (C) to adjust distance of the mirror from cab.

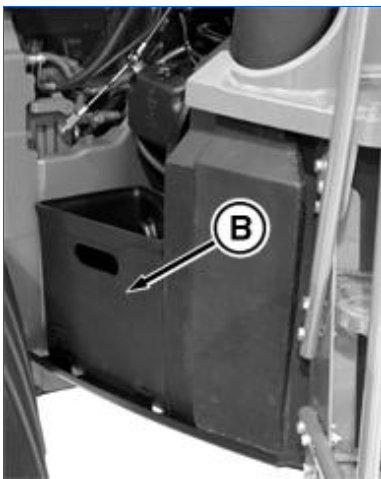

- B - Storage Compartment

#### *NOTE:*

*Early models had storage capability for tools in battery compartment. Current models have tool box on left side of tractor with no storage space in battery compartment.*

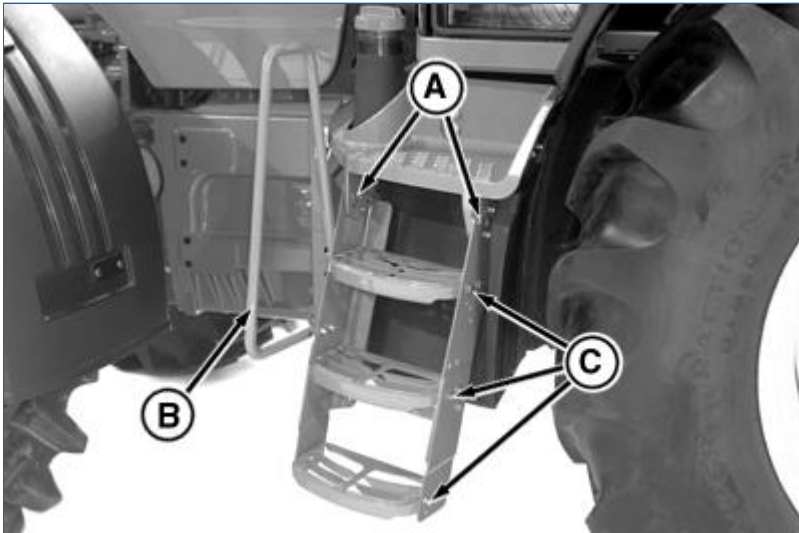
Remove retainer (A) and cover to gain access to storage compartment (B).

### Positioning Steps and Handrails



RXA0056383-UN: Position Steps and Handrails

#### LEGEND:

- A - Step Angle Bolts
- B - Handrail
- C - Step Positioning Bolts

### Steps

Step assembly can be adjusted to accommodate various row spacings, crop height or attachments.

Change step assembly angle by removing bolts (A). Move step assembly and install bolts.

### Handrail

Handrail (B) should be positioned in conjunction with the steps.

Change step position by removing bolts (C). Move step and install bolts.
