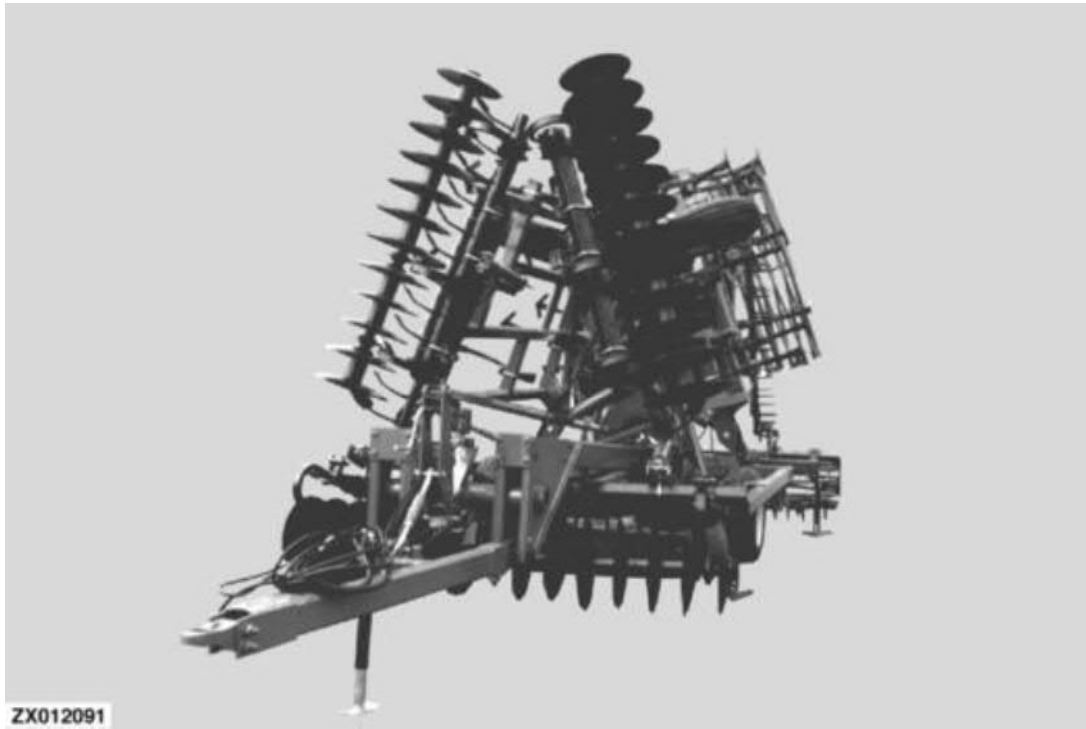

Never ride or permit others to ride on machine.

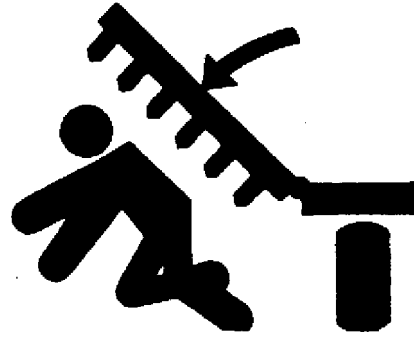
Stay clear of ditches or creeks during operation.

ALWAYS have tractor stopped on level ground when raising or lowering wings.

ALWAYS shut off tractor and shift to "Park" or set brakes when leaving tractor.



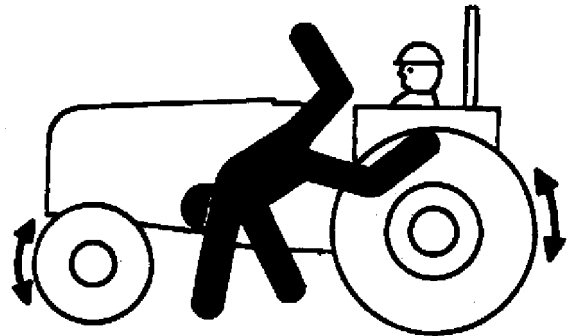

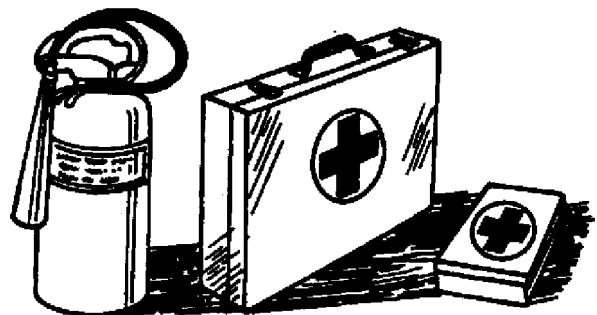

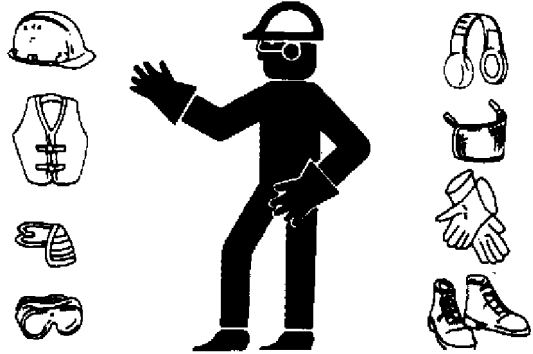

Operating equipment safely requires the full attention of the operator. Do not wear radio or music headphones while operating machine.



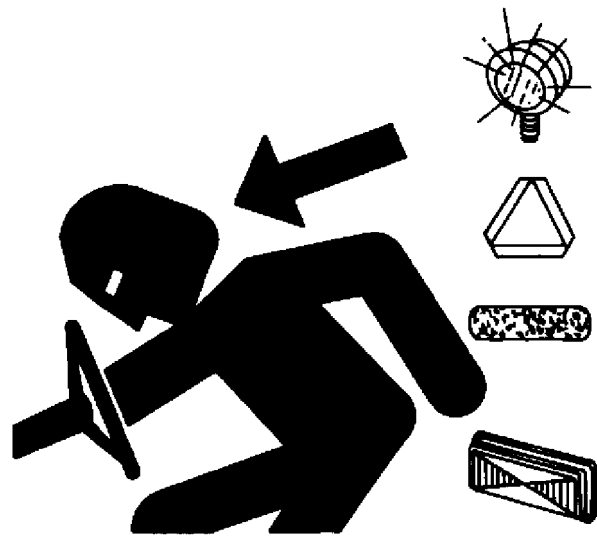

USE SAFETY LIGHTS AND DEVICES

Prevent collisions between other road users, slow moving tractors with attachments or towed equipment, and self-propelled machines on public roads. Frequently check for traffic from the rear, especially in turns, and use hand signals or turn signal lights.

Use headlights, flashing warning lights, and turn signals day and night. Follow local regulations for equipment lighting and marking. Keep lighting and marking visible and in good working order. Replace or repair lighting and marking that has been damaged or lost.

TRANSPORT SAFELY

BEWARE of overhead wires and KNOW the transport height and width of your machine. See Specifications section.

ALWAYS fold wings fully and install transport lockups on depth control cylinders.

Travel at a reasonable and safe speed.

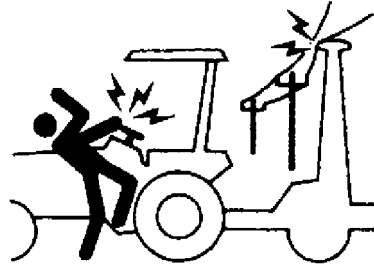
Latch the tractor brakes together.

Shift the tractor into a lower gear when transporting down steep slopes or hills.

Keep the SMV emblem and reflectors clean and visible from the rear.

Always pin drawbar in center position for ALL tractors when transporting.

When transporting the machine on a road or highway at night or during the day, use lights and devices for adequate warning operators of other vehicles. In this regard, check local governmental regulations. Various safety lights and devices are available from your John Deere dealer.
